Social and Fundraising Committee

The Artarmon P&C Social and Fundraising Subcommittee organise events and activities which address the twin objectives of having fun together and raising money for our school.

It is a tradition that Year 3 parents take responsibility for leading fund raising activities within the school. The logic behind this idea is that by Year 3 parents are generally familiar with how the school works, and have probably attended one or more events, and yet their children still have enough years left at the school to benefit from the hard work of their parents' raising funds.

At the beginning of the school year, the newly formed Year 3 social and fundraising committee meet with the principal and talk through the teachers' wishlist and other suggestions of potential items that the committee could target their fundraising towards. The committee then select the most popular item(s) and this is the fundraising goal for that year.

In the past 15 years the P&C has raised funds to build the classrooms at the north-eastern corner of the McMillan Rd site, the COLAs (Covered Outdoor Learning Areas) in both playgrounds, the playground equipment that was until recently on the Abbott Rd site, and provided electronic whiteboards to most classrooms.

The goal 2016 was to raise money to upgrade at least three Smartboards in classrooms to interactive touch screen LED TVs.

The 2017 goal is to raise money to purchase robotics teaching programs for all grades.
