

## Questions for Home Reading Comprehension

While you are reading you might like to think about some of the following questions.

### Predicting

#### Before reading

- What do you think this story will be about?

#### During reading

- What do you predict the problem in this story will be?

#### After reading

- Were our predictions correct? Why/why not?

### Connecting

#### Text to self

- Do you know anyone like this character?
- Has anything like this ever happened to you?

#### Text to Text

- Does this book/story/ event remind you of anything?

#### Text to world

- What does this remind you of in the real world?

### Inferring

- What can you infer (guess) about the main character?
- Why did the character do that?/ why do you think the character is feeling that way?
- What do you think the character is thinking?
- The character must be feeling \_\_\_\_\_. Are there any clues that help us know that?
- What do you think is going to happen next? What do you already know that helped you to predict that? What clues did you use?

### Clarifying

- What do you think the word \_\_\_\_\_ means?
- Are there any words you don't understand?
- Are there any sentences you don't understand?

### Summarising

#### After reading

- What is the main idea of the story?
- What were the main events that happened in this story?
- What was the problem or the complication?
- What was the solution or the fix to the problem?
- What was the purpose of this text?
